Legal Immigration Refugee Resettlement Program

Today we had Leo Hohmann on our radio broadcast. He started looking into the illegal immigration problem, and as he did, he found that there was a big problem with legal immigration, especially the refugee resettlement program. There was a lot of positive media attention on the refugee program, but no one had ever looked at its dark side.

We had been bringing in a lot of people from communist countries since the 60's and 70's, but now more and more were coming from Islamic countries which were governed by Sharia Law. The Sharia legal system does not fit with our laws and Constitution. There is also the issue of assimilation once they get here. The fact is, there is very little assimilation into our culture.

Islam has a very different set of values than those of us in the West. The first issue is that they don't believe in a separation of mosque and state. For them religion, politics, culture, and government are all one. Islam is a religion, but it is also more than a religion, it is a complete system that governs every area of life.

Eighty-five percent of the imams in this country are foreign born. They have been educated in one of two major universities, one in Cairo, Egypt, and the other in Saudi Arabia. They come here with very little knowledge of the US system of government. They have no idea what is in our Constitution and our Bill of Rights. They have no understanding of our First Amendment, freedom of speech, freedom of the press, and freedom of religion. These are the bedrock values of America.

The number of mosques has exploded in this country. There are four times as many as there were on 9/11. We are in a mosque building binge in this country.

This brings up the question, Who is leading these mosques? It should concern us that eighty-five percent of them are led by imams who are schooled in Saudi Arabia and Egypt. They have degrees in Sharia Law from one of these two major Islamic universities. The imams must have this education in Sharia Law if they want to be registered imams. We are not talking about radical Islam, we are talking about mainstream Islam.

We keep hearing about radicalization, radicalization by Youtube videos, and self-radicalization. It is much more insidious than a Youtube video. We have mosques in this country that are teaching about Sharia and jihad. This is the part of the problem that no one wants to look at. I know that this is a very complex problem in a country like America where we have freedom of religion. We have to have evidence, we can't just go around raiding mosques. This would set a precedent that would allow them to raid our churches.

We have to find the line that goes beyond the freedom of religion, and becomes sedition. I propose we take a look at the religious visa program in this country. Most of these imams come in through this program. We need to find out their agenda when they come here, and maybe give them a crash course on our system. We need to make it clear to them that there are lines that cannot be crossed or they will be held accountable.

We have reported on the undercover journalists, especially in Great Britain, have done reports on the things being taught by these imams. Some of these things are horrifying. I realize that because of our freedom of religion, the state has to be very careful how they handle these things.

When we talk about eighty-five percent of the imams coming from these universities, we are not just pulling this information out of the air. Pew Research has put out a lot of studies on this.

We also need to look at who is funding these mosques. Seventy to eighty percent of the mosques in this country are at least partially funded by Saudi Arabia. The Muslim Brotherhood is funding a lot of them through their front organizations. We know that the Muslim Brotherhood is a very seditious organization. It was founded in 1928 in Egypt.

There is a bill in Congress that would declare the Muslim Brotherhood a terrorist organization. Other countries, Egypt included, have already done this. Countries like Egypt, Russia, and the UAE have banned the Muslim Brotherhood. Even Saudi Arabia, which funds a lot of Brotherhood operations, does not want them in their own country.

The UAE has not only named the Muslim Brotherhood a terrorist organization, it has done the same for CAIR, the main Islamic advocacy organization here in America. I believe that the bill in Congress to declare the Muslim Brotherhood a terrorist organization, it would do the same for some of its offshoots, like CAIR.

The Muslim Student Association is another front group for the Muslim Brotherhood. It is doing a lot of damage on our college campuses, turning American students against Israel and giving out a lot of anti-Israel and anti-American propaganda.

A lot of this information is documented in Leo Holman's book, [Stealth Invasion](#). This book grew out of two and a half years of research and writing for World Net Daily on the subject of Islamic immigration and all of the out of control programs.

There is a lot of data in the book, but Leo has tried to make it as readable as possible. There are a lot of true life illustrations that have happened in various cities and small towns across America which have been transformed by the refugee resettlement program.

There is also a chapter on Europe in the book. It shows what is ahead for America if we do not stop what some of these programs are doing.

This is the heartbeat of Fortress of Faith. I spent 29 years in Europe. I saw Sharia Law developed there. In fact, the town that is the headquarters for Sharia Law in the UK is where I lived for much of those 29 years over there. My church was about five miles from what is now the headquarters of Sharia Law in the UK. If we look to Europe, we have a crystal ball that shows our future if we don't do something now.

This whole issue is not about terrorism and stopping the next terrorist attack, although we will see more of those. It is about slowing the advance of a subversive culture that we have nurtured in this country. If we don't stop it, it will ultimately undermine our freedom. It is a very intolerant culture. The Left talks a lot about tolerance, yet they have formed an unholy alliance with the Islamists, which is another topic covered in Leo's book.

Secular leftists have attached their train to the Islamic train, and this is a scary thing. It has been in the works for some time, but has really come into fruition over the last six to eight years under the Obama administration. Before Obama we saw the Muslim Brotherhood working in both parties, Democrat and Republican. There is still a little work going on in the Republican party with some congressmen receiving money from Brotherhood organizations, but it is now mostly the Democrat party and the leftists. They are working with the Brotherhood to undermine our society.

Leo recently wrote an article for WND about the [fraud in the refugee program](#). Mary Doetsch, a recently retired U.S. State Department veteran has published a whistle-blower letter in the Chicago Tribune fingering the refugee resettlement program as fraught with "fraud" and "abuses." This is a real bombshell because it is very rare to get State Department employees, even when retired, to open up about this kind of thing. She affirmed much of what is in Leo's book.

The United Nations picks our refugees. They are not vetted well at all. It is more about the numbers and the money than helping people who need help. Christian refugees have been abandoned in the Middle East, especially in Syria where ISIS was hunting them down and killing the husbands and children in front of the women, and then making the women into sex slaves. ISIS is doing brutal, horrific things that we cannot even imagine. In spite of this, ninety-eight percent of the refugees have been Sunni Muslims. The Sunni Muslims are the group doing most of the brutal persecution.

Many of those, not all, that we are bringing in are themselves the persecutors. We are ignoring the Christians. Only 0.5% of the Syrian refugees are Christians. It is really deplorable. I would go so far as to say in is criminal on our side.

We can't continue to shake our heads and say this is terrible, and not do anything about it. Leo's book informs us how there has been a parallel society, a nation within a nation, building over the last thirty-five years or so. This is going to have very bad consequences in the near future. It will be like what is happening in Europe if we don't change. His book, and many others, will do us no good if we just read them and put them on the shelf. We need to share them with others. We must talk about them with our families and discuss them with our local officials.

Our local leaders need to be aware of this. One of the insidious things about the refugee program is that it is controlled by the federal government in partnership with nine contractors, many of them religious organizations like Catholic Charities, Lutheran Social Services, Episcopal Migration Ministries, etc. They are making money off the program. These are the people who will come into your community and tell you how great this program is, but they won't tell you that they profit from it. They get paid by the government for every refugee that comes in. They present it as if it is about humanitarianism, when, in truth, it is about money and transforming communities.

This information needs to be disseminated to our local government officials. Our local governments are not even informed about how many are coming, and from which countries they are coming. In many cases they are notified after the fact. The local communities are not given the funds to look after the refugees after they are settled. The schools are impacted, there are translation issues, and many more burdens placed upon the local communities.

The nine organizations that bring them in, abandon them to the local communities after about three months. The local communities have no say, it is just dumped on them.

One of the things that really troubles me is that these contractors are mostly religious organizations, for the most part “Christian,” who are supposed to be serving God first, yet they sign contracts saying that they will not proselytize, they will not evangelize these refugees. Their financial interests supersede their obligations before God. They are willing to help the physically, but are not willing to help them in their spiritual needs. They are willing to let them follow a false religion that will lead them to Hell. They even buy Qur’ans and prayer rugs for them. They also hire Muslims for many of their management positions.

What is going on is shameful. They will quote Scripture about how we are supposed to help the stranger in the land. They will say that it is their biblical responsibility to do this, but they will ignore their responsibility to evangelize for fear of losing the financial benefits.

They are not even doing the humanitarian things they cite Scripture for because they are doing it with government money, and only for a short time. They are making millions in the process.

Another action point is, we should call our congressmen and tell them we want this Muslim Brotherhood terrorist designation law to pass. It has been sitting in Congress for months. It is just stalled there with no action being taken. Paul Ryan will not bring it up for a vote unless he is put under extreme pressure to do so.

We are to be soldiers of the Cross. Lets stand at the corner of truth, and have the courage to fight for that truth.

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
