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Reviving America

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Syrian Refugee Security Crisis - Part 2

Segment One

The Broadcast associated with these notes was recorded before Thanksgiving and there was fear that there may be a terrorist attack either on Thanksgiving Day or on Black Friday. There was an attack in Colorado Springs, but it doesn't seem, at this time, to be related to Islamic terrorists. At the time our greatest concern was for Black Friday because there are so many soft targets available.

The treat of Islamic terrorism is such that it behooves those who can to arm themselves when out in public. The attack in France could have been less deadly had there been armed people in the theater who could have taken out the shooter. The jihadis were able to empty their weapons and reload multiple times and, since no one was armed, the people could not defend themselves.

Soft targets are places where, first of all, people are busy and not paying attention to what is going on around them. Secondly, they are places where there are a lot of people and they cannot defend themselves.

Another reason we were concerned about Friday is because Friday is a day when Muslims have their weekly prayers. A pattern for this type of attack is that they often happen after weekly prayers. This is not just a coincidence. They have listened to their imams preach their sermons inciting the faithful to carry out the commandment of Muhammad to fight those who believe not. These people get pumped up and go out to do their dastardly deeds.

We can thank our security forces that we were not attacked over the last two days. The holiday weekend is not over, but so far they have kept us safe. I am thankful for the hard work they do in spite of the fact that in many ways their hands have been tied by the Obama administration.

Even though there has not been an attack, we need to be vigilant because the threat is still real. There has been much chatter about an imminent attack. ISIS even put out a video with a list of cities where it is threatening attacks.

Megan Kelly on Fox News had Morton Storm on her program on November 17th. It is quite probable that this is not his real name. He is Danish and is a former member of Al Qaeda who became a CIA double agent. His sources said that there would be an attack on American soil in the next two weeks. It is interesting that he said this is a credible threat and the head of Homeland Security says there is no credible threat. 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Segment Two

The Hypocrisy Of Obama Concerning The Refugees

At the summit in Turkey, Obama doubled down, and even tripled down, on his desire to bring these Syrian refugees into the US. He said that there should be no religious test for refugees. This doesn't hold water when we see that 92% of the refugees are Muslims. Only about 3 or 4% are Christians. Think about this. How many Christians are being killed and forced to flee their homes by ISIS?

In the past Obama has not been for bringing in refugees from Iraq because of security concerns. Now he says it doesn't matter that there are security concerns, let's open our borders and let them in. He tells us that it is un-American and that we have no heart if we don't let them in. I like Ted Cruz's response. He asked, "It is un-American for me to want to protect my family?"

In 2011 [Obama put a hold on processing refugee requests from Iraq](#) because several dozen terrorists had infiltrated into the United States through the program. Was it heartless in 2011? No, he was just being sensible. Now that he doesn't have to be concerned about re-election he is letting them come in spite of the security risks. He doesn't care about the consequences as long as his agenda is fulfilled. I am afraid that his agenda is not pro-American. He doesn't have to worry about re-election, but his decisions will affect Americans for generations to come. We have talked before about how the intelligence community says it is impossible to properly vet these refugees.

Another hypocrisy is when Democrats say they don't want to break up families by deporting illegal immigrants. Breaking up families didn't seem to bother them when they raided the home of Elián González and forcibly take him from his fathers arms and send him back to Cuba. There was no compassion for a refugee in this case.

In 1978 Shahram and his family came to the US on a temporary visa, hoping to get a green card and stay in America. In 1979 his mother returned to Iran to finish her time as a teacher so she could get her retirement and leave that money for her sister. During that time the hostage crisis happened in Iran. It lasted for 440 days and only ended when Ronald Reagan was sworn in as President.

Jimmy Carter was President at the time. Remember, he was a Democrat. He issued an order revoking the visas of every single Iranian in the US who was not a citizen or a permanent resident. If you were a student, if you were on a temporary visa as Shahram's family was, your visa was revoked.

Shahram's mother was in Europe on her way back from Iran. She went to the American Embassy to get her passport stamped so she could return to America and was informed that her visa had been revoked. He did not see his mother for 2 ½ years. They had to move to Canada so she could rejoin her family.

This shows how the Democrats use terms like heartless and un-American when it suits their agenda, but when it does not, they have no compassion. How un-American and heartless was it to break up Shahram's family?

I think the greatest hypocrisy is coming from within our churches. How many who call themselves Christians are hollering at us for speaking out against the refugee resettlement program? We don't see the outcry for the persecution of Christians and the fact that most Christian refugees are denied access to the US. Something is really wrong when they open the door to the Muslim refugees, but keep it mostly closed to the Christian refugees.

It Is Not Radical Islam

Radical means something outside of the normal. Radical Islam means something that is not normal to Islam. Those who call the jihadis “radical Islam” are saying that jihad is not normal to Islam. However, jihad and instilling terror in non-Muslims is exactly what Muhammad taught and did. Muhammad is the example Muslims are to follow and he is the highest authority within Islam. 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Segment Three

Why Should We Be Concerned?

Should we be concerned about taking in 10,000 refugees from Syria? This is 10,000 this year and 100,000 next year. Obama says these people will be vigorously screened. I don't know how he is going to screen them, maybe with suntan lotion, because there is no data to screen them against.

The Syrian Ambassador says:

“Among the refugees, who went to Europe, maybe more than 20 percent belong to ISIS groups. Now Europeans (and other Western nations) have invited this threat into their homelands. It will only get much worse in the future,”

In Europe that would be hundreds of thousands. The French President took a hard stance against ISIS, but showed his foolishness when he said they would still receive Syrian refugees.

Another source quoted an ISIS affiliate who said that an estimated 4,000 ISIS operatives have infiltrated the refugees in Europe.

Obama wants to bring in 10,000 this year, not counting those who are already here, another 100,000 next year, and another 100,000 in 2017 making the total 210,000. Do the math, 20% of the known Syrian refugees are potentially ISIS operatives, that would be 42,000 ISIS operatives in the US by the end of 2017. Let's say that it is much less than that, maybe only one tenth of that, that would still be over 4,000. Look at what they did in Paris with only 8 or 9 terrorists. Remember what 19 Islamic terrorists did on 9/11. The risk is just too great.

We are not saying we don't want any refugees. What we are saying is that the Refugee Resettlement Program is so flawed and so broken that we have no idea who we will be letting in.

Michael Steinbeck FBI Assistant Director, Counter Terrorism, said:

I said there's a lack of databases so we learned our lesson with the Iraqi refugee population. We put in place a ??? wide background and vetting process that we found to be effective.

The difference in Iraq, we were on the ground collecting so we had databases to use. The concern in Syria, the lack of our footprint on the ground in Syria is the databases will not have the information we need so it is not that we have a lack of process, it's there's a lack of information.....

The head of the FBI said we can query the database until the cows come home, but nothing will show up because we have no record on them. Countries like Syria, Iraq, Somalia and others have no way to track refugees coming from them. ISIS has a footprint in these countries so this is a legitimate concern.

There are other issues on the screening process. It is not the FBI that screens the refugees, it is Homeland Security in cooperation with the Justice Department and the United Nations. Shahram spoke to a person in Homeland Security who is part of the screening process. He has interviewed refugees, and he told Shahram about some of the issues. The first issue is fraudulent passports. At least 5 to 10% of those claiming to be Syrians, maybe more, have fraudulent passports. This means they are from other countries.

The second problem is that a large percentage of the refugees have actually destroyed the fingerprints on their hands. They have filed them off, cut them off, or used acid to remove them. How do you vet someone you can't fingerprint? The administration officials tell us that there are other biometrics that can be used. How? There is no database.

Many of those who do have passports, have birthdays that don't match up. Many of them have the birth date of 01/01 of a given year. What are the chances that all of these people are borne on January 1st?

More than 30 governors have said we need to halt this refugee resettlement process because there are credible security issues. Most of them have only written a letter to the administration. Two states, Texas and Louisiana, have actually done something. Both of these states have issued an executive order.

Shahram's contact said that he had rejected many applicants because of a lack of screening. He said that when the quotas were due, orders came from above saying those who had been rejected were now approved. The screeners are doing their job, but they are being overridden by their supervisors.

Segment Four

These refugees will be living on welfare because they don't have good work skills. Many of them can't read or write so it is going to cost the communities where they are housed.

The UN hand picks the refugees. The State Department then works with local non-governmental organizations called NGO's, We need to understand that there is a ton of money at stake for these NGO's. There is at least 1.5 billion dollars at stake for these organizations. These organizations put together the packets and get the screening going. This part of the process has no screening.

The NGO in Twin Falls ID said they don't care what the Governor says, they are the ones that are bringing them in. The state government has no roll in the process. The state governors have no knowledge about who the federal government is relocating to their states even though they will be charged with their care. As I said before, the system is broken and corrupt.

Remember, the NGO's make money off the refugees. They are paid for every person that is brought in through their group. Because of this these NGO'S are coaching the refugees to help them get past the screening. Some of these NGO's are Christian charities, but they are not allowed to evangelize them because they are taking federal money.

Again, it is not that we don't have any compassion, but if they can't pass the screening we don't want our nation to be endangered by Islamic terrorists.

Another ex-Muslim who is now a Christian paster named Mark, was in Austria working among the refugees. The refugees are confined to the refugee centers until they are properly vetted. He worked among Iranian and Afghani refugees and said that they are legitimate refugees escaping war and are very open to the Gospel. He said they were able to see more than 100 Muslims come to Christ in the 2 weeks they were there.

On the other hand, the refugees from Syria were very closed to the Gospel. They had money, and they were not being housed in the same areas with the others.

Mark was on a train and there was a woman who was supposedly a Syrian refugee with her daughter. He speaks Arabic, and he heard the woman tell her daughter to speak the Bismillah, and Islamic prayer loudly to sanctify the train for Allah. This is the attitude of the "refugees" from Syria.

Obama tells us that we don't care about the widows and the orphans. Let me tell you about the Boston bombers. The mother was a widow who was allowed in as a refugee with her 2 boys. She raised them to hate America and to love Allah and his ways. Should we be afraid of the widows and orphans? Yes, if they are raised to hate America and follow the ways of Islam.

Some bring up the Good Samaritan, and say we should be more like him. The Good Samaritan took money out of his own pocket, it wasn't the government reaching into his pocket to pay for it.
